



Where's the end of it?

'Special Divine Healing Meeting' with Dr. Jaerock Lee

How could the people, who had not had a minute of sleep, be filled with so much joy and delight as they welcomed the dawn? Amidst the fiery works of the Holy Spirit, no traits of fatigue could be found in the faces people giving their testimonies.

It was the manifestation of God's Word, "But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall" (Malachi 4:2).

"The Special Divine Healing Meeting" that began at 11 p.m. on November 28 at Manmin Central Church was packed with such people.

On the last Friday of every month, there are "divine healing meetings" during the second half of the Friday All-night Service but the November event was "special" as Dr. Jaerock Lee was going to lay his hand on each of the sick and pray for them.

In the first half of the Friday All-night Service, Dr. Lee proclaimed in a message titled "God the Healer" (Exodus 15:26) that "As most diseases stem from sin, we can be healed once we destroy the wall of sin standing in our way to God, repent, and come before Him by faith."

To people who did not know what "sin" was, this message shone a ray of light on the hearts that have grown numb while battling the illness, and during a praise of repentance, sounds and tears of people rending their hearts in repentance could be heard throughout the Main Sanctuary. Soon, a sense of urgency was detected in their faces. Following the prayer to receive the Holy Spirit, the Senior Pastor began to pray for about 2,000 patients on the floor of the Sanctuary, and as soon as he began an innumerable number of people began to fill the lower stage of the altar. The following are only a few samples of their testimonies.

Sang-O Hong (male, 54), who had not been able to use his legs since the paralysis that struck him down 2 years ago, stood up from his wheelchair and began walking. Gi-Jung Han (female, 62) had been diagnosed with cancer in the duodenum but in fear of the cancer spreading to other parts of her body, she had been under drug treatments instead of undergoing an operation. She was led to



Manmin after reading Dr. Lee's book "He Never Stops!" and after receiving the prayer, she testified that the lump had decreased in size. Deacon Joo-Myung Suh (67), suffering from spondylolysis, felt a severe pain whenever she stood up or walked up and down the stairs, but was healed after receiving the prayer. Deacon Il-Bong Park (65), declared first-degree visually impaired by the government, came to see 3 years ago by the Senior Pastor's prayer and this time around, Deacon Park saw a flash when Dr. Lee prayed, felt his surroundings brighten up, and could soon see even small letters clearly.

Deaconess Choon-Sik Kim (66) was healed of Parkinson's disease from which she had been suffering for 10 years; Senior Deaconess Jung-Nim Lee (70) was healed of phlegmone; Rev. Goon-Pyo Hong (male, 49) was healed of fracture in his ankle; Bin Yoo (female, 5) was healed of sensitized dermatitis; and Deaconess Jae-Kyung Jeon (33) of Muan Manmin Church experienced the full restoration of her eyesight for the first time in 17 years and threw away her eyeglasses. Many other diseases were healed and God's healing works continue to this day.

After Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee finished praying, there was a thunderous applause from the church members who had witnessed the moving works of the Holy Spirit. Even if some people had attended the Meeting half in doubt, listening to testimonies would have sufficed to empower them with faith.

What is the common thread among people who received God's works of healing of diseases and infirmities?

Most of them had attended the 2-week divine healing meetings held at the Manmin Prayer Center and had prepared for this Meeting in prayer and fasting. Furthermore, they have made every effort to live by the Word, understand their sins, rend their heart in repentance, and displayed their faith with precious offerings. As the Bible tells us that "faith is the assurance of things hoped for" and "Faith was working with his works," God's healing of their diseases and answers to their prayers was a testament to the fact that God is alive.

In a coldhearted time in which no one dances or mourns to the tunes of the flute and to the singing of a dirge, and no one believes without seeing signs and wonders, God's power manifested through the healing and answers to prayers is God's earnest cry of love through which He tells us, "I am indeed alive."

After a meeting with Rev. Peter Kim at Kinshasa Manmin Church, I have come to admire and love Manmin Central Church and Rev. Dr. Jaerock Lee. If I could be of assistance in any way to "The 2009 DR Congo Women's International Conference and Crusade" with Mrs. Boknim Lee (President, Manmin Prayer Center) scheduled to take place next year, I will do everything in my power and I am going to assist Kinshasa Manmin Church in whatever way I can.

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New Chapter of 'Acts' Written in Belarus, Ukraine; 'Christian Revolution Brought Forth by Gospel of Sanctification'



The works of the Holy Spirit were in full swing in Eastern Europe. Hosted by the Spiritual Diplomacy Movement based in the United States, sponsored by Manmin Central Church, and with performances by Manmin's Performing Arts teams, "The Belarus & Ukraine Handkerchief Meetings (Acts 19:11-12)" took place, November 12-26, 2008.

Since receiving overflowing grace from the works of the Holy Spirit and the gospel of sanctification manifested and proclaimed by Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee, Main Speaker Dr. Mikhail Morgulis (67; President, Spiritual Diplomacy Movement) has been conducting meetings in different parts of the world with the handkerchief on which Dr. Lee prayed.

Christian Meeting Held in Belarus despite Governmental Restrictions

A Christian meeting of any kind took place for the first time in the impenetrable nation of Belarus. This particular meeting, with an

official approval from the government, took place in the Concert Hall of the presidential residence in Minsk, on November 14.

Following the performances by Manmin Central Church's Performing Arts teams, Dr. Mikhail Morgulis comforted the brothers and sisters in Christ who had held fast to their faith despite persecutions and afflictions, proclaimed to them the gospel of sanctification, and encouraged them. When he prayed for the sick afterwards with the handkerchief on which Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee had prayed, many people glorified God on account of the healing they had received from Him.

This meeting was a huge success, attended by approximately 2,000 people that included government officials and other prominent members of the Belarusian society. An evening news program on the state-run ONT TV set a new precedent by reporting on the meeting on at least 3 occasions. Local pastors did not hesitate to say that the meeting was a "Christian revolution brought forth by the gospel of sanctification."

Additional meetings took place on Sunday, November 16, at Grace Church where Bishop Sergey, of the 500-plus-member Belarus Churches Association, serves as Senior Pastor, and at Bethany Church in the evening.

Unlike other republics of the former Soviet Union, Belarus has seen and made steady improvements since its independence in 1991 and especially under the firm governing of the current President

Alexander Lukashenko. While the government is said to recognize the freedom of religion, there are many restrictions placed on Christian activities and many churches are kept alive underground.



Ukraine: Melting pot of the Holy Spirit that led to spiritual triumph

Only about 2.19% of all Ukrainians are said to be Protestants but the works of the Holy Spirit were set ablaze in this land nevertheless.

The handkerchief meetings took place at the Cherkassy Philharmonic Theater on November 19 and at the October Palace Concert Hall in the capital city of Kiev on November 22. On Sunday, November 23, two meetings took place at Salvation Church, affiliated with the Pentecostal Denomination and one of the largest in Ukraine, with more than 3,000 gathered in total.

Following sermon messages by Dr. Morgulis, many people, including a woman who had the vision in one of her eyes restored and an elderly man who had been stricken down by paralysis but started walking, magnified God for the manifestations of His power among them.

Dr. Grigory Komendant, Executive Director of the European Baptist Federation and President of the Ukrainian Bible Society, observed, "This meeting was a spiritual triumph that blanketed Ukraine and Belarus with Dr. Jaerock Lee's gospel of sanctification."

The November 2008 meeting took place not only for the cause of saving souls but also to promote a World Christian Doctors Network (WCDN) conference scheduled to be held in Kiev, Ukraine, in October 2009 and physicians from the 2 nations expressed their interest and intentions to attend the WCDN event.

Fine arts transcend tradition, ideology, and the barriers of language. Performances by the members of the Performing Arts teams of Manmin Central Church more than sufficed to warm the hearts of and breathe in an air of courage to all those who had steadfastly held on to their faith.

Participants of the meetings, after seeing our praising and fan and angelic dances, did not hold themselves back in saying that they had just seen "the best performance" of their lives and called the performers "angels from Korea."

When we all sang "How Great Thou Art," everyone stood up from his seat and became one in the Holy Spirit. Tears and joy from the depths of our hearts bound all of us together by the belt of the Holy Spirit and the belt of the truth. Praising and dance performances destroyed the strong wall of distrust and clothed the participants with the love of Our God.

Rev. Sergey Khomichi, President of the Union of Christians of Evangelical Faith in Belarus, confessed, "The fact that a Christian meeting was held in a public place in Belarus is a miracle. The performance at my church was also the first of its kind. The performers from Korea has taught us what it is to praise in spirit," and expressed his gratitude.

A Prepared Vessel

"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest" (Luke 10:2).

By the power of God, anyone can bear abundant fruit. Yet, each individual must be prepared to be worthy of God's use. If one is not prepared, the amount or magnitude of fruit and reasons for thanksgiving will be correspondingly small. In God's kingdom and in an individual's life, the more prepared a vessel is, the more abundant a harvest and reasons for thanksgiving will be.

After a harvest, a wise farmer prepares for the following season by making a point of meticulously considering all of crops. By the same token, we must look back on the past year, examine the fruit we have borne, and strive to reap a greater harvest in the coming year.

Let us delve into "the prepared vessel" of which God speaks and examine our own hearts.

1. Someone Who Does Not Involve Fleshly Thoughts

In accomplishing His work, God seeks people who will not involve or mix fleshly thoughts but adhere only to His will. In Luke 10:12, Jesus tells us, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." While it can be gathered from this verse that there are not enough laborers, it can also be concluded that there is an earnest need for laborers who will work according to God's will. Even if a worker for God's kingdom is available, if he follows not God's will but fleshly thoughts, it is as though that worker is not present.

Of course, any worker of God will strive to adhere to God's will. However, there are many instances in which workers of God will not do so.

1 Samuel 15:9-23 is a scene in which Saul disobeys God's Word and does as he pleases. Even though Saul is told to "utterly destroy" the Amalekites but he brought back their king and sought to sacrifice to God sheep and oxen he had taken from them. It may at first appear as a brilliant idea but Saul had only disobeyed God's Word. No matter how good and sensible my own ideas and thoughts may seem, they will be useless as they are not part of or related to God's will. Even if it is beneficial to God's kingdom, if God's law is violated the act will merely be the result of fleshly thoughts.

Romans 8:7 tells us, "The mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so." In other words,

without the shattering of fleshly thoughts, an individual will continue to act in accordance with what his thoughts tell him is in the right and thus be unable to subject himself to the law of God.

The prophets of the Old Testament era, disciples of Our Lord, and the Apostle Paul faced trials in order to have their fleshly thoughts shattered. One can wholly obey God only without fleshly thoughts, and the destruction of fleshly thoughts calls for the individual to root out every element and remnant of evil and untruth in his heart and fill it with goodness, love, and the truth. However, as the Holy Spirit dwells within each individual today, he can quickly throw out fleshly thoughts as long as he obeys His voice. Only then will he follow after the desires of the Holy Spirit and come forth as a worker God seeks.

For instance, suppose God assigns you a task that is difficult for you to comprehend at first. Even so, if you relentlessly make every effort to follow after the voice of the Holy Spirit and pray to God, He will show you the way. If you begin to involve fleshly thoughts, your heart will be troubled, you will make mistakes while doing God's work, and you will face constant interruptions and interferences. When you follow after the desires of the Holy Spirit, however, every aspect of the work will prosper and, even if things do not seem to go swimmingly at first, they will do so in the end.

2. Someone Who Embraces All People with a Heart of Goodness

God seeks vessels in whose good and virtuous hearts any and all souls can find rest. A church is a place where people of all different types of backgrounds, environments, knowledge, circumstances, and personalities gather. At times, some people come to church not to believe in God but for some other purposes. A prepared vessel must embrace even such individuals and lead them onto the path of salvation.

In Luke 5:32, Jesus tells us, "I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance." By equipping himself in a good heart with virtue and love, a prepared vessel must transform anyone and breathe in life.

To this day, I have met many different types of individuals. Even if I embraced them in goodness, there were those who paid back in evil or even in betrayal. There were people who grossly blasphemed against the

kingdom of God. On their account, there were times at which the congregation and I were gravely afflicted in the heart. Still, I had not for once hoped God to punish those individuals. I prayed in tears with an earnest desire for them to repent, turn from their ways, and receive salvation. Even today, as I am waiting for them to come back, the doors to the church remain wide open and I cannot adequately express with words my joy upon seeing some of them coming back.

Furthermore, in nurturing workers with whom I will accomplish God's kingdom, I have done so only in faith, hope, and love. No matter how much an individual may have lacked, I hoped and believed that God would one day transform him into a great worker and provided him with everything I had.

3. Someone Who Gives Thanks in Any Circumstances

In accomplishing the works of the Lord, there can be instances in which it is difficult to give thanks. Such are the times when the difference between a prepared vessel and an unprepared vessel becomes evident. A prepared vessel turns the circumstance under which he cannot give thanks into a reason for thanksgiving, and then magnifies God.

The life of the Apostle Paul was a series of such events. Throughout the course of his life, Paul came across more situations in which he could not be grateful than situations in which he could. Nonetheless, Paul transformed even those situations into reasons for thanksgiving.

Suppose you were falsely beaten, framed, and imprisoned while preaching the Gospel. How would you feel? The Apostle Paul wholly gave thanks to God and praised Him. Then the prison doors opened and on this account, the jailer and all his household received salvation, an event through which Paul bore the fruit of the Gospel. In a situation in which it was difficult to give thanks, Paul actually ended up bearing abundant fruit and magnified God.

The apostles "[rejoiced] that they had been considered worthy to suffer shame for His name" (Acts 5:41). Even when it was hard for them to give thanks as they were beaten and persecuted on account of the Gospel, the apostles still gave thanks. This is the type of people in whom God is interested.

Therefore, I urge each of you to give thanks even in times you cannot. As you confess that what you are facing is an opportunity of God's blessings and move forth in faith, you will receive the blessings

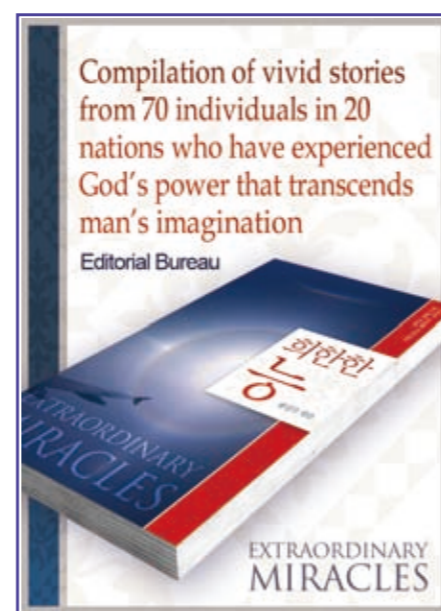
and magnify God per your confessions.

God fulfills all of His Providence. However, there are times when the progress is slow in coming or being achieved. This is the evidence of the love of God who desires each of us to come forth as a prepared vessel. The Almighty God can accomplish everything swiftly but, according to His love and justice, when we are not prepared He cannot accomplish them. As the preparedness of the heart, the faith, and all circumstances and conditions must be in order, God will wait. Instead of giving His children the visible and tangible fruit right away, God will first lead their souls to prosper.

What good would it do, even if the fruit were borne and the works were accomplished immediately, if the souls of His children have not prospered and their faith has not grown? By His love, God leads the faith of His children to grow and their souls to prosper.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, when we fix our eyes on God's works through the eyes of faith and obey Him by destroying our fleshly thoughts, we will be able to experience the power of God who magnificently accomplishes all of which He has spoken. Furthermore, when we have come forth as prepared vessels, God will give us without restraint all that we ask Him and the blessings we receive at that time will be firm.

May each of you come forth as a prepared vessel used for God's kingdom and magnify Him greatly by understanding God's love of great depths, in the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ I pray! ✝

A Letter from Abroad

Prayer from Seoul manifested instantaneously in Israel

Dear Dr. Jaerock Lee,
I thank the Lord for you and your ministry, and for your dedication to manifest God's power to this world in these and times.

I am translating your books "My Life My Faith 1 & 2" into the Hebrew language. The Lord has blessed me and my husband, Pastor Suhail Dabbagh very much.

This is our son Lysanias, and this picture was taken when he was 6 months. He is now 13 months old. After a night with some fever, at 2:30 PM this Friday (October 10) he turned blue due to virus reaction. We did take him to a medical center, but they sent him back home after 20 minutes. One minute after his arrival, I tried to give him water, but he shouted and his eyes glazed and was stiff again, even stronger than before.

Dear pastor, I believed that the Lord would heal him through your prayer, for I believe the truthfulness of each word that is written in your books. I sent the prayer request and watched the live broadcasting of the service on the internet.

When you started praying for my son at 5:20 PM with our time, I laid my hand over his picture, together with our youngest daughter, and prayed with you.

Our son woke up much earlier but his fever kept coming up. He ate and slept for an hour from 8:00 PM until 9:00 PM. His temperature was up to 40 degrees, but amazingly he did not lose consciousness. That was just after your second prayer for him.

Both my husband and I checked ourselves in front of the Lord to make sure that we have nothing blocking between us and Him. After that the Lord revealed to you what the problem was. The virus came through his mouth into his blood, and you prayed even stronger on that 3rd time, and the virus spread stopped! That moment was the turning point with our son. Suddenly, at 9:40 PM after your 3rd prayer, the temperature started dropping down and he was sleeping. But at the same time his hair was sweating although the air conditioning was on. His hair was full of sweat for more than 3 hours. All the children of the emergency room were crying and shouting, even the parents. Our child was asleep in such peace, no fever, no cramps, just sleeping in peace. He slept that night for 10 hours.

The next morning he woke up like nothing happened, and he was full of energy, running, laughing, eating and playing.

The tests did not show anything. We thank the Lord and thank you for taking the time for prayer and for being sensitive to the instructions of the Holy Spirit.
