

Deacon 'Pig' shares, "Here Is the Secret to My Success."



Deacon Joonhwan Chung
(General Manager of Exportation and Importation / Hasseop Team Leader for the Chung P&C Laboratory for Breeding Pigs)

Joonhwan Chung is a professional consultant in the livestock business. Nicknamed Deacon 'Pig' at church, he works at the Chung P&C Laboratory, one of the nation's top hog breeding general consulting agencies. He is a frontline pioneer in the livestock consulting field with his benchmarking skill in livestock breeding. With his special expertise, he is now making a huge contribution to the development of Korea's livestock business.

In December 1997, he was led to this church through his wife's dream. He had worked at an artificial insemination center for pigs for 8 years, and was in charge of breeding and general sales. When foot-and-mouth disease prevailed in 2002, he had the experience of having 60 of his pigs (each worth 5 million won, or \$5,000 in US currency) protected under the prayer of Dr. Jaerock Lee. But due to the foot-and-mouth disease, his company went through restructuring, so he decided to start his own business, which seemed more promising. He opened a pet store which was considered profitable, but the business was a failure.

While praying for a job, he was hired in August of 2007 at the Chung P&C Laboratory. He started out as a worker for the Breeding Pig Importation Part of the company for 6 months. He worked diligently to import only the best quality pigs and so increased the company's revenue. From February 2008, he learned the work of HACCP, a new division of the company, and became a professional consultant. HACCP operates quality control of all meats such as pork, chicken, duck, beef, etc., to make sure

no harmful substances from the farm go into the meats. With proper education of all the workers, HACCP provides quality control to help companies to become nationally certified companies. And with Chung's skill, his company's passing rate streamed to the top, so more and more contracts came pouring in.

Every Sunday morning at 5 a.m., Chung wakes up and prepares to meet the Senior Pastor. Why does he do this every week? Because whenever he talked to the Senior Pastor about his business and received his prayer, Chung experienced his problems being resolved and turning into blessings. There were also changes in his life of faith. He used to compromise with the world with a burning motive. But as his heart became more peaceful, his attitude changed, and he gained confidence as he tried to think through everything with goodness and tried to treat everyone with kindness. God helped him come up with good ideas for his lectures, and He also helped him make HACCP contracts with many farms.

Also, as a group leader, he visits church members' houses every Saturday with other workers in the Men's Mission. While visiting many church members' houses, the members received solutions to their problems, and Chung himself experienced his own problems being solved! He felt overwhelming joy when long-term absentees began attending the church again, and when families came to Christ through his visits.

"After experiencing the change in my thoughts and deeds, I received more answers by meeting the Senior Pastor. I have many weaknesses. But whenever I met the Senior Pastor and told him about my business, and he prayed for me, all the problems were resolved. The way God works is totally different from our own thoughts. Usually we tend to think impossible things are just impossible. But in faith, even impossible things turn into possible things, and possible things become even greater possible things. My life is filled with blessings after since I obeyed the words of the Senior Pastor who clearly presents the will of God and earnestly prays for me."

Chung is now a HACCP instructor for the Education Center for Livestock Health at the National Agricultural Cooperative Federation, and he has received material blessings; as his salary has increased threefold, and he receives unprecedented incentives at the laboratory where he works. And the company he works for has matured into a leading company with huge revenues in the livestock industry.

Receiving Much Blessing after Being Nicknamed as "Deacon Common Octopus"

One day in 2000, while leading a happy day to day life after giving birth to our first child, we were suddenly startled when our son began crying loudly and couldn't breathe properly. His face began turning dark. My wife and I were so scared that we didn't know what to do. We rushed to the hospital with the baby.

The doctor diagnosed him with an inborn heart disease and bronchial stenosis. I never imagined that this kind of thing would happen to me. Having led a lukewarm life of faith, I had to choose between depending on God and depending on medical science. I thought I was living according to God's words when I lived without difficulties. But when I faced this reality, I couldn't show my faith. The baby went to heaven while receiving treatment at the hospital.

Through this event, my wife and I thoroughly looked back at our lives. We didn't actually have spiritual faith which pleased God. My wife realized that she had neglected her God-given duties and life of prayer because of her pregnancy, and repented. Since that time on, we attended worship services in spirit and in truth. And we tried to participate in every event where we could receive grace. Tasting the true meaning of God's word was so sweet and gracious that each day was a continuation of happiness.

At that time, I realized one very significant thing. Even though I had seen many signs and wonders and heard many testimonies, I lacked gratitude and love toward the Senior Pastor.

In March 2003, my wife, Deaconess Eunyoungh Kim received prayer for an easy delivery and gave birth to our healthy daughter, Sun-A. Because we had this child after sending the first one to heaven, we were more thankful and rejoiced. Leading a life of faith filled with the Holy Spirit, we gave thanks to God and the Lord and also to our Senior Pastor. In April, 2004, after Women's Mission Devotional Service, my wife suggested that I offer common octopus, which is a specialty of Muan, to be of a little strength to the Senior Pastor. So I said, "Great idea! People say that common octopus even makes a collapsed cow stand up, so it'll be great if this could

give a little strength to our Senior Pastor."

Once a month, we headed for Seoul early in the morning with fresh common octopus we got at the Muan common octopus market. Even when I had no earnings while preparing for another job, I prayed, "God, please allow me enough at least to offer common octopus to the Senior Pastor." Then, God answered my prayer!

Beginning September 2007, the door of blessing began to open. I told the Senior Pastor that I would open up a used furniture discount store and received prayer from him. Starting with the contracts, everything went very smoothly. In the first month, we were able to offer three hundred thousand won (about \$300 in US dollars) as our first tithe. I decided to commit everything to God. Every month, we took common octopus to our Senior Pastor and offered mission offerings and received prayer. And the amount of our tithes increased more and more.

Finally, in 2009, I received enough blessing to be able to give one million won (about \$1,000 in US currency), and sometimes as much as 1 million and 25 won (\$1,250) as my tithe. In addition, we moved to a bigger office in June 22, and also into a new and bigger apartment in July.

After accepting our pure and simple hearts and unchanging deeds, God blessed us to experience "Impossible things becoming possible, and possible things becoming even greater possible things".

Healing Cases Presented at the 6th International Christian Medical Conference Held in Kiev, Ukraine

From October 30-31, the 6th International Christian Medical Conference was held in Kiev, Ukraine. About 400 doctors from 30 different countries including the US and Russia participated in this conference. Especially this year, many doctors from Muslim countries in Central Asia such as Azerbaijan, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, and Kyrgyzstan attended, and there were also doctors present from Latvia, Poland and Moldova.

Doctors made a presentation about the cases of healing performed by God's power from a medical point of view. Especially the cases of Deaconess Haeok Choi (Daejeon Manmin Church) and Bro. Myungjin Shin (Masan Manmin Church) who were healed of peritonitis and Yoonsong Lee (Manmin Central Church) who received the healing of neck abscess drew much attention from the participants.

This 6th healing case was presented by Pastor Daniel Rozen, Organizing Committee Member of the 2009 Israel United Crusade. He glorified God while presenting a

After the Conference ended, President of

WCDN, Dr. Gilbert Chae (General Surgery Clinic Director at Shinchon Yonsei Hospital) said, "I could feel that many who gathered here were eager to hear about divine healing. Many doctors confessed they were happy to learn about WCDN, and wished to continue working with WCDN. We at WCDN will continue to do our best to awaken medical doctors and other intellectuals through cases of healing performed by the power of God."

WCDN was established in 2004 to confirm God's healing works from a medical point of view. Annual conferences have been held in a different country each year. The 7th conference is planned to be held in Rome, Italy in 2010.

The general assembly for each mission is being held and through the general assembly, new leaders who will carry out God's work in 2010 are being elected. Those who are longing for God-given duties are preparing for the general assembly with prayer.

Overflowing Testimonies at the Divine Healing Meeting Led by Dr. Jaerock Lee

The Divine Healing Meeting was held in the main sanctuary of Manmin Central Church during the second part of the Friday All-Night Service on October 30. Divine Healing Meetings are held in the last week of every month during the second part of Friday All-Night Service. The Divine Healing Meeting is attended by not only Manmin members, but also people from all different parts of Korea and even from overseas to be healed of disease or receive

answers to their heart's desires and prayers. Also at the last Divine Healing Meeting, many came up on the altar to testify about their healing, including Senior Deaconess Soonrae Kim, 55, who was healed of lumbago, and Wanhee Kim, who received healing from a hearing problem. THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT Patience

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law." (Galatians 5:22-23)

In many cases, being happy or not being happy depends on whether one can be patient or not. When we want to receive an answer from God, the fruit of His answer depends on our patience. But the spiritual meaning of patience and the worldly meaning of patience is quite different. The worldly people also endure, but most of them have patience of the flesh.

Imagine the anguish people experience while having to exert self-control over their ill-feelings or lusts! They may frown, clench their teeth, shake all over, or even get sick! Some people stop eating and drinking and still others lose sleep. This is an example of patience of the flesh. In other words, you are practicing flesh with evil in the heart. Spiritual patience is not enduring with evil, but enduring with goodness in the heart. If you endure with goodness, you can overcome difficulties with thanksgiving and hope. As a result, you gain a bigger heart.

If there was no flesh or evil in this world, then we would not have to have patience with anything. If you have the fruit of patience in your heart, your feelings don't waiver in any given situation. If you have a heart that is always at peace and you can melt the heart of other people around you, words like 'patience' or 'forgiveness' don't really take on great meaning. We can categorize spiritual patience into three parts.

The first is the patience to change the heart.

If we have a lot of anger, arrogance, greed, self-righteousness and frameworks, it is difficult to be patient. But as we cast away evil and become sanctified, it becomes easier and easier to be patient. Luke 8:15 says, "But the seed in the good soil, these are the ones who have heard the word in an honest and good heart, and hold it fast, and bear fruit with perseverance." Namely, those who have a good 'soil of the heart' can be patient until they bear good fruits. But in reality, we need to have endurance as we make an effort to change our hearts into good soil. We have to make ourselves obedient to the truth by praying

fervently with all our hearts and with fasting.

The same goes for sinful natures. You have to pray and change your heart until you completely pull out the root of the sinful nature. But if you are not patient, your determination is weakened and you become lazy while circumcising your heart. Or, just when you think you have cast out something, you discover that it's still inside of you, and you feel very discouraged. You may find forms of untruth still in you while trying to pull out the original root of sinful nature, but this doesn't mean you didn't make any spiritual progress. If you keep on peeling without stopping, the onion will finally disappear. It's the same with sinful natures. When you constantly try to circumcise your heart with faith in this way, your soul will prosper and all things will go well with you.

The second kind of patience is the patience with other people.

When you interact with people who have different personalities and education from your own, you may experience some uncomfortable situations. But those who

long for sanctification will be patient in any kind of situation with any kind of person and maintain peace at all costs. They always try to understand others with a good heart and endure while seeking the benefit of others. Even when others act with evil, they bear with them. They pay back this evil only with goodness, not with evil.

When evangelizing, visiting church members, or training church workers, long patience is needed. Even though the work may take a little longer, and you know the fruit of the work will not be as abundant, you should be patient and wait for trainees to gain clear understanding on their own through their experiences, so they can be more capable workers in the long run. It might be easier if the leader who has abilities is apt to just do the work for them, or if he replaces that person with somebody who is more capable. But the reason why you have to endure until the end is for the sake of each soul. This will accomplish the kingdom of God more completely.

If you sow the seed of patience in this way, you will certainly gain the fruit of blessing according to the justice of God. And if you endure with the souls you are

tending to until they change, praying for them with tears, you will eventually gain a big enough heart to harbor all of them. As a result, you will gain the authority and power to revive many souls. Also, if you control your heart and sow the seed of endurance even in the face of false accusations, God will let you reap the fruit of His blessings.

Third is the patience in your relationship with God.

This refers to the patience that you should have until you receive the answer to your prayer. There are many promises in the Bible that God will answer His children's prayers. But in many cases people don't receive their answers because they are not patient enough. Men may ask for an immediate response, but God may not answer them immediately. God answers them at the most appropriate and opportune time because He knows everything. If the subject of their prayer request is something big and important, God can answer them only when the amount of prayer is filled.

If we do not have true faith, we cannot wait until we receive what we ask God for in prayer. We may pray and fast to ask God, but if the answer doesn't come quickly enough, we may just give up, thinking God isn't going to answer us. If we have the faith to really receive the answer, we have to pray and act with faith until we actually receive the answer as the fruit. Also, even when we go through some refining trials of the heart or persecutions in our Christian lives, we can bear good fruits if we have patience.

Therefore I hope that you will accomplish true patience in your life, your faith and your heart mature so that you can experience God's blessing and answers that He promises you (James 1:3-4).

MMTC Is Looking for New Trainees!

Nowadays, we see the signs of the last days recorded in the Bible becoming clearer. Also, God who said, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" (Isaiah 6:8) is more anxious to find His true workers at this critical time. He is looking for workers who will go out and spread the gospel with the heart of the Lord.

Since its founding in 1982, our church received a vision toward world evangelism from the Lord. From that point on, we have been praying without ceasing, and devoting ourselves with our hearts and offerings. Establishing MMTC (Manmin Missionary Training Center) was also a part of this effort. Now MMTC is recruiting its 20th class of trainees. We urge Manmin members who have a vision toward world missions to enlist and participate.

Training Organization for Future Missionaries

MMTC (Manmin Missionary Training Center, President Deborah Lee) was established in September, 1997. Starting from the first class in October of that year, it has had 19 graduations as of 2009. The graduates are now working in 11 countries including the USA, India, Nepal, Belgium, China, Thailand, etc. Thirty-seven of them are serving the Lord as missionaries, thirty-nine as missionary candidates and eight as pastors.

With a vision to establish mission centers in major cities around the world and cultivate many missionary candidates, MMTC has been training people with its unique and effective training programs through God's powerful works.

MMTC is building cooperative networks by planting mission fields, sending-off missionaries, through literary missions, holding seminars, running the "Message of the Cross" camps during Vision Trips around the world. All these activities consist of theory and practice. First, the trainees receive various, dynamic education needed in ministry, and they study the Bible and then experience real, hands-on missionary activities. In addition, MMTC is now undergoing preparations to take even newer steps toward world evangelism.

Qualification for Trainees and the Training Process

Qualified trainees are baptized Christians who are registered members of the church, who have a dream and vision toward world missions. Even those who received baptism

at a different church are qualified; as long as they are registered members of the church. In addition, applicants should be in good health and have no problems with traveling to overseas countries and have at least a high school diploma.

The training is made up of two parts: the first part consists of a regular study course and the second part is an internship. During the first part, which is the regular course study, trainees will listen to lectures for 3 months, and after taking a vision trip and conducting research and making a presentation of a certain mission field. Then, during the second part of the training, they will participate in a ministering internship for 3 months, followed by a short-term mission trip (6 months). After finishing the entire training, they will be interviewed and commissioned as a missionary according to the church

denominational laws.

The training program consists of three categories: mission praxis, mission adaptation and strategy, and equipping through the Word. They learn about the overseas vision trip, short-term mission, ministering internship, and lectures include: Communication in Different Cultures, Leadership and Teamwork, Practical Preaching, Spiritual Gifts and Missions, International Etiquette, Healing Mission, Broadcast Mission, Regional Studies, Administration of Missions, Planting Churches in Different Cultures, Spiritual Equipping through the Word, Introduction to the Old and New Testaments, Church History, Introduction to Missions, The Fivefold Gospel, and Preaching Practicum. Especially through the vision trip, the trainees have a chance to apply what they learned to their mission field and experience ministering in other countries.

Before being commissioned as a missionary, trainees make a clear decision about where to go and in what direction to lead their mission, through the vision trip. Beginning January of 1998, starting with the first vision trip to Japan and Taiwan, MMTC has been taking vision trips to West Asia, China, Europe, Russia, Southeast Asia, and Indochina. Because there are many cases where a mission field is decided, and then a commissioned missionary is sent to that region, the vision trip is considered a "Field Operation" through which trainees have the chance to research the spiritual, cultural, economical and social situation of their mission field, and prepare for their future ministry.

Through the message, I repented of my past, and while fasting and praying with the thought, "How could I pay back the grace of the Lord?" in my heart, I received the vision to work for mission in Africa. In 1998, while being trained in MMTC, I gained a clear vision about the African mission which seemed just vague while attending various programs. In November of that year, I was commissioned to Nairobi Kenya where Bishop Dr. Myongho Cheong works. I was ready to obey with 'Amen' whenever the Lord called me. So I had no fear about the things to come.

Once an egg vendor, the fact that I am now saving souls in Africa as a missionary is like a dream. In 1997, after joining our church, I got to hear the testimonial sermon of

After I arrived in Kenya, I realized that there was nothing I could do with my own thoughts; I had to do everything with prayer. Though I received training through MMTC, I had to be trained again in a real ministry setting. The most difficult thing of all was communication, because of the short preparation time I had. Because I was unable to set apart a specific time for studying, I had to memorize English vocabulary words by sacrificing some sleep. I disciplined myself with a determination heart that I wouldn't sleep unless I reached my daily goal. So before long, I could understand and speak English pretty fluently. I always experience God's help in my ministry when I rely on God with faith in the scripture, "Everything is possible for him who believes" (Mark 9:23).

Now I am devoting myself to praying earnestly to become a powerful servant to spread the holiness gospel in 54 countries in Africa.
