

# “God answered my mother’s prayer when she’d asked Him to be my Father!”

Junior Deaconess Nami Shimizu (Tokyo Tabata Manmin Church)

I’m a 29-year-old housewife living Saitama Prefecture near Tokyo, Japan. Had I not met the living God, I would still be tormented by the same illnesses that had had a hold of me for 10 years. But now, I am grateful to God who has healed me and given me spiritual strength, and find myself rejuvenated.

## Troublemaker from discord at home

I’d been a troublemaker. From my parents’ divorce and discord at home, I became defiant and, while befriending other troublemakers, I fell into deeper holes. I was expelled during the first year in middle school and forced to find another one, only to be expelled from there as well.

My mother Senior Deaconess Shimizu Jihye had come to Japan to make a living when I was in second grade. Can you imagine how disheartened she must have become to hear that her daughter had been expelled from school in the middle of her puberty years? In October 1998, she brought me to Japan. I began to adjust to a new life in a new country, starting middle school at the age of 17. I entered a community college to study “Secretarial Studies” when I turned 23 and by the end of my first year, I worked as a Korean interpreter/translator at electronics manufacturer Panasonic.

I think it was on account of my mother’s prayer that I faced no major difficulties while living in Japan. As she felt terrible about me at all times, she strove to do for me whatever she could and never forgot to pray to God for her daughter. “God! Please allow my daughter Nami to accept the Lord. She’s a poor kid who’s grown up without a dad. Please be her Father.”

## Realizing mother’s love through endometriosis and pneumothorax

My menstrual cramps had been severe since high school

years but I spent years, merely thinking that my pain was slightly greater than that of my peers. Then in 2003, I was diagnosed with endometriosis. The left ovary had swollen and if it were to swell even more, the doctor said the left ovary would have to be removed. Still, as long as I could endure the menstrual cramps, I was fine otherwise.

Then in December 2008, I had caught a cold and my chest started hurting while coughing. I was diagnosed with endometriosis (an abnormal presence of air in the pleural cavity resulting in the collapse of the lung; may be spontaneous, due to injury to the chest, or induced as a treatment for tuberculosis). I needed to undergo an operation in which my left chest would be punctured and a tube inserted to remove the air. It also turned out that pneumothorax had been caused by endometriosis.

From that point on, I would have a relapse of pneumothorax. Yet, as the necessary operation would open up my chest and as the operation would not guarantee a full recovery and only leave a large scar, I was told that it would be better not to have an operation. An alternative method was to stop having periods. As I was not yet married at the time, however, I wanted to wait and see.

I was tormented nearly a half of every month from endometriosis coupled with pneumothorax. A week prior to starting the period,

heart. ‘There must be so many things she just could not tell others about.’ I began to cry uncontrollably as I remembered how powerless she must have been and felt at times.

“Mommy! I’m so sorry. It’s my fault. I’m so sorry to have troubled you all these years. Thank you, Mommy. I’ll be a good girl from now on.”

## Reading Hell, a life transformed

My mother began attending Tokyo Tabata Manmin Church in January 2004. Her hope was that I would one day start attending church but I could not get myself to go on Sundays. She prayed for me and, for years and years, urged that I come with her.

After getting a copy of Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee’s book *Hell* and reading it, my life began to change. I thought that I should no longer open up my heart to the world but ought to believe in God and become a good believer.

So I began attending Tokyo Tabata Manmin Church. My heart was actually at peace once I began going to church. As the Senior Pastor at the time was proclaiming a series of messages on “Hell,” his words pierced my heart even more deeply and sharply. As I saw Biblical wonders and signs as well as works of God’s healing as manifested through the Senior Pastor, I began to recognize and distinguish true faith and made every effort to possess spiritual faith by which I could live my life by the Word.

As I obeyed the Word of God who told me to “Do this,” “Avoid that,” “Keep this,” and “Cast that off,” I could feel my heart transformed. My body also began to improve little by little.

## Forming a family of harmony and receiving God’s healing

In April 2009, I started a family of harmony with a man I had met at a gathering of Koreans living in Japan. That October, I attended a handkerchief meeting conducted by Rev. Kyeongtae Jeong. I heard then and there the voice of the Holy Spirit, saying, “When your faith strengthens, your body shall also strengthen.” I came back to my seat and began praying. At that moment, like a flash, all the sins and flaws I had committed up to that point in my life went through my mind and I rent my heart in repentance. From that day on, I felt or detected no symptoms of endometriosis or pneumothorax.

“Ha! I feel completely fine! I want to eat! I want to eat!”

I was craving food and feeling no pain. I told this to my mother and Rev. Kyeongtae Jeong also. I can’t describe how delighted the church members were!

I am happiest and at most peace on Sundays when I worship God and share the fellowship with my brothers and sisters in Christ. I serve the church as a helper who reads the praise lyrics for the congregation prior to the Sunday Evening Services and Daniel Prayer Meetings.

“Now that I’ve come into New Jerusalem past the gates of pearl, Flashing before my eyes are the events of the past—”

Whenever I sing along those words and reminisce about the past, I can only give thanks to the Lord who has saved me and I am touched by the tender love of the Senior Pastor.

Whenever I cherish and sing along each passage in praise songs, I find myself shedding tears springing from the depths of my heart.

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## NRB President/CEO Dr. Frank Wright Visits Manmin TV and Manmin Central Church

## Ushering in the Dawn of the Gospel in Kazakhstan



Handkerchief Meetings took place in five regions throughout Kazakhstan, March 12-20, 2010. Many people had long desired to hear the gospel of sanctification and works of God’s power, and the mission team had a firsthand experience of the importance of literary mission work. “The people of Kazakhstan have not yet forgotten the way in which they had been touched at the 2009 Israel United Crusade,” said the mission team upon their return from a nine-day journey throughout Kazakhstan after a series of handkerchief meetings.

This series of handkerchief meetings took place at the request of believers who had experienced God’s power at “The 2009 Israel United Crusade with Dr. Jaerock Lee,” held at the International Convention Centre in Jerusalem in September 2009.

The mission team conducted handkerchief meetings and baptism ceremonies in Almaty, Karagandy, Kyzylorda, Aralsk, and Baikonur

Provinces and regions throughout Kazakhstan. At each meeting, an introduction of Manmin’s ministry to the audience was followed by the screening of “Power,” a video introduction of the ministry of Dr. Jaerock Lee. When Rev. Daniel Rozen prayed with the handkerchief of God’s power (Acts 19:11-12), the deaf began to hear, many others received God’s healing, and a variety of spiritual problems were resolved.

Rev. Daniel Rozen is a member of the Crystal Forum (an association of Israeli pastors) that hosted “The 2009 Israel United Crusade.” After receiving the spiritual power from Dr. Jaerock Lee’s mission work in Israel, Rev. Rozen is active in conducting meetings with the

The mission team had a firsthand experience of the effect of “The Israel United Crusade.” Senior Pastor Rosa and 10 members at The Spiritual Path Church in Almaty said they were unable to forget the way in which their hearts had been touched at “The 2009 Israel United Crusade.” They had received God’s healing of disc, impaired hearing, polio by Dr. Jaerock Lee’s prayer in Jerusalem and that having attended “The Israel United Crusade” was the turning point of their lives from which they have been receiving abundant blessings. The mission team also learned that many believers in the country were reading Russian editions of Dr. Jaerock Lee’s published works and requests for additional copies flooded

wherever the team visited. Their love for the gospel of sanctification was also passionate. Many believers in Kazakhstan were listening to Dr. Jaerock Lee’s sermon messages at the church’s website (www.manmin.org/russian) and watching on TBN Russia Dr. Lee’s sermon messages at 3:30 a.m. every morning. They magnified God, testifying that they have been not only come to understand God’s Word in spiritual terms but also experience the works of His healing.

This mission trip welcomed five churches in Kazakhstan to join the Manmin family as branch churches and countless people accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior.



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# Heart

"For the kingdom of God does not consist in words but in power" (1 Corinthians 4:20).

There were so many wonders and miraculous signs in the early churches that people praised the believers and the number of the church members increased every day (Acts 5:12-14). It proves the kingdom of God does not consist in words but in power. When the Word of God is confirmed with signs and wonders, the believers can possess true faith, stand firm on the truth, and lead a victorious life.

We cannot enlarge the kingdom of God with the wisdom and speech of men, nor can we struggle against and overcome the enemy devil. To the extent to which you change your heart by the truth and accomplish the heart of God, you can receive His blessing and manifest His power with to expand His kingdom. Then, what do we have to do to accomplish perfect heart of spirit that God wants?

### 1. You have to act with goodness in every matter.

You've heard a lot about what is a good heart and what is an evil heart. So now you should be able to easily discern between good and evil. If you have truly cultivated such a heart, then you must have peace in you because you are at peace with God. You would always be filled with joy and fullness of the Spirit and you would also be able to give your peace and comfort to others and give them the strength to practice the truth. Your deeds would set a good example for others. And even though you may know the truth well, as long as you have many fleshly thoughts and you don't cultivate the truth in your heart, there will be no peace in you. You insist on what you think is right, thereby causing difficulties for the people around you.

When choosing between good and evil, do you always choose the side of goodness? In your everyday lives you cannot really face a situation like Daniel being put into lion's den or like Ruth having to give up everything in her life. You can't always choose the side of goodness when you can't let your 'self' and ego 'die' even in very trivial matters. Luke 16:10 says, "He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful also in much; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much." Only those who always choose the side of goodness in little things of everyday life are able to also choose goodness in a difficult situation.

God knows the heart of each one and

measures it accurately. Even though it may be such trivial evil, if it's not goodness, then it is still evil. The character of your heart will be formed depending on your moment to moment decision to choose goodness or evil. When you choose goodness even in small things, your heart will be filled with goodness, and choose the goodness in any circumstance even though it means you lose all your possessions and even your life.

### 2. You should follow God's will, and not your self-righteousness and frameworks.

Those who are following their righteousness and frameworks will try to force others to accept their ideas. If you are acting with evident evil, it is relatively easy to realize the wrongdoings. But if you have self-righteousness and frameworks thinking you are living by the word of God, it is difficult for you to realize your evil. Especially, if your self-righteousness and frameworks were made by wrongfully applying the word of God, it is even more difficult to realize it. For this reason, sometimes you might still insist on your self-righteousness and frameworks, even though you come to understand what God's will is. It's because what you think seems to be similar to the will of God. You justify yourself thinking, "God's will is this. But, that is not really against the will of God, either."

Those who follow the will of God accomplish peace and consider others with a heart of gentleness. On the contrary, those who follow their self-righteousness and frameworks might have conflicts with others. Even though it might look like they are acting in the truth in the eyes of men, they are not able to bear good fruits. This is the same

in everything. While the Holy Spirit is telling you a certain thing is the will of God, and if you say another thing is also the will of God, then, God's true will cannot be accomplished. I urge you to reflect upon yourself with this message and with a humble heart. I hope you will completely break down your self-righteousness and frameworks and follow the will of God in all things.

### 3. You should come forth as a true child of God.

You can have the perfect heart that God desires of you if you cast away evil and choose goodness; if you demolish your own righteousness and frameworks; and if you follow the will of God. God is looking for true men and women of God who have such perfect hearts. The true men of God in our context are not just those who are used to accomplish the works of God. They are the ones who have completely recovered the image of God having blameless, spotless, and holy hearts. Even though you know the truth very well and experience spiritual things, and even though you are faithful in so many duties, you cannot become true women of God just with those things.

But not all people since the creation have recovered the image of God. Countless people were born since Adam, but only a few actually cultivated the kind of heart that God desires of men. Those people walked with God and lived a life revealing the glory of God. Elijah performed power that was unimaginable for human beings and even brought down fire from Heaven. Abraham was ready to make a sacrificial offering to God of his only son, Isaac. The apostle Paul became faithful with life-giving love and fiery fervor. How happy God must have been whenever such people came forth!

Whether in your homes or in the church, and in whatever you do, remember God all the time. I hope you will say each word and have each thought only in the truth, so that you can be spotless and blameless. Then, God will acknowledge you as true children of God and receive glory greatly through you.

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# The More One Learns about the Passion and the Resurrection, the Deeper His Faith Grows

"Let us once again embrace the Lord of the Resurrection"



### THE PASSION

Following the Last Supper, Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane to pray for the providence of salvation He was about to fulfill. There, by the betrayal of Judas Iscariot, Jesus was arrested and taken to Jerusalem. After interrogating Him through the night, the high priests decided to accuse Jesus of treason against Rome and have Him killed.

In the end, Pontius Pilate sentenced Jesus to death and Jesus became subject to mockery and torture at the hands of the Roman soldiers. After bearing the cross to Golgotha amidst countless onlookers, Jesus was crucified (Mark 15:25; Luke 23:26-33).

### THE CRUCIFIXION

The duration during which Jesus was hung on the cross and died was about six hours (from 9 o'clock in the morning to 3 in the afternoon). Wearing a crown of thorns and having been flogged, Jesus was nailed in His hands and feet, and spilled all of His water and blood after having been pierced on His side. In order to redeem us from our sins, Jesus offered Himself to God as an atoning sacrifice.

### THE RESURRECTION AND THE ASCENSION

After confirming Jesus' death, the Roman authorities handed the body of Jesus to Joseph of Arimathea and permitted him to bury Jesus (Luke 23:50-54).

High priests and the Pharisees, remembering Jesus' words that He would be raised from the dead on the third day, sealed His tomb with a large stone and placed guards by the tomb. As He had promised, Jesus rose from the dead on the third day. Following His Resurrection and during the 40 days afterwards, Jesus revealed Himself to many people.

As Christianity is also called "a religion of resurrection," Jesus' Resurrection is at the heart of the Christian faith. Moments before His Ascension, the Lord commanded His disciples to "be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth," told them to await the coming of the Holy Spirit, and ascended into heaven.

### BIBLICAL EVIDENCE OF THE RESURRECTION

At the dawn on the third day following Jesus' burial, Mary Magdalene and other women came to Jesus' tomb with spices to anoint Him. However, they found that the extremely large stone that was in the way of Jesus' tomb had been rolled away and the tomb empty. Surprised, they entered the tomb but did not find Jesus' body.

When the women were perplexed, angels appeared before them and told them of Jesus' Resurrection (Matthew 28:1-7; Luke 24:1-7). The women informed the disciples, who also found the tomb empty and then returned home (Luke 24:10-12; John 20:1-10). However, Mary Magdalene wept outside Jesus' tomb and there, she became the first person to come face to face with the Lord after His Resurrection.

Afterwards, the Lord manifested Himself to two of His disciples on their way to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35), and He dined with His disciples at the Sea of Tiberias (John 21:1-14). In addition, the Lord appeared to more than 500 brothers at one time and to James as well.

EASTER IS A FEAST COMMEMORATING THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS WHO DIED ON THE CROSS BUT ROSE FROM THE DEAD ON THE THIRD DAY. THROUGH HIS DESTRUCTION OF THE AUTHORITY OF DEATH AND THROUGH HIS RESURRECTION, THOSE OF US BELIEVING IN HIS RESURRECTION CAN PARTAKE IN THE HOPE OF OUR OWN RESURRECTION.

### THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE RESURRECTION

If Jesus had not resurrected, the spreading of the gospel is an act of lying, our faith worthless, and we "are of all men most to be pitied." However, as Jesus rose from the dead according to God's Word and became the first fruits of those who are asleep, "For as in Adam all die, so

also in Christ all will be made alive" (1 Corinthians 15:20-22). Therefore, the Resurrection declares Jesus Christ the Son of God (Romans 1:4) and is the fulfillment of the prophecy on the Resurrection (Luke 24:46). Furthermore, it gives the believers a conviction of forgiveness of their sins and a hope of faith (1 Corinthians 15:17).

### EASTER MEMORIAL PERFORMANCE THE LOVE OF OUR LORD

*Resurrection! Glory! The Return! The Lord of Love! He has resurrected as He said He would.*

*"Where are You, My Lord? Why are You there, Lord of love? Gaze at me, My Lord, So that I may engrave Thy face in my heart. Do not stay there but come to me, The Lord of my everything. Come before me and be with me, My Lord of love abounding in His love."*

At the direction of the Performing Arts Committee and under the theme "The Love of Our Lord," an Easter Memorial Performance was presented during the second part of the Friday All-night Service on April 2, 2010. More than 400 actors, staff members, choir members, and members of the Nissi Orchestra presented stage five acts (Prayer, Ministry, Passion, Crucifixion, and the Resurrection of the Lord) that will touch the hearts of all in attendance. The accompanying music, which God Himself had revealed to Manmin, added to the grace and the blessings. The performance will be broadcast live to the entire world via Global Christian Network (GCN).



### THE HOLY WEEK

The week prior to Easter Sunday is called the Holy Week. During the week that begins on Palm Sunday, believers mediate on the Passion and remind themselves of the love of the Lord. On the Friday on which Jesus was crucified, it is recommended that believers fast for at least a meal.

### EASTER SACRAMENT ON EASTER

Sacrament includes baptism and Communion. At Manmin Central Church, baptism takes place one week prior to Communion, which in itself takes place at Easter and the Feast of the Harvest, and on Thanksgiving Day. In

commemoration of the love by which He died on the cross and shed His blood for us, the congregation eats bread and drinks grape juice. It is a ceremony that also reminds us the believers of the kind of lives in Christ they are to receive eternal life.

### EGGS AT EASTER

At every Easter, members at Manmin Central Church share the news of the Lord of the Resurrection with their neighbors and share the joy of Easter with one another by distributing beautifully decorated boiled eggs.
