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“The Lord Saved Me from the Horrific Pain of Atopic Dermatitis!”

In early 2014, some people reportedly chose a drastic option because of pain caused by atopic dermatitis. A high school girl committed suicide due to atopic dermatitis. And a woman in her thirties strangled her eight-year-old daughter who had worsening atopic dermatitis and then killed herself too. These incidents shocked people.

Atopic dermatitis (AD) is chronic and recurrent inflammatory disease that usually occurs in early childhood or childhood. The precise cause is unknown, but its onset is related to genetical factors and the malfunctioning of the immune system. It is also believed to be caused by combination of various other causes including dry skin and itchiness beyond normal range; bacterial, viral, or fungal infections; emotional causes; and certain environmental causes.

The National Health Insurance Corporation said that the number of people who visited hospitals for AD between 2008 and 2012 is approximately 1.04 million. The actual number of patients is much more, affecting an estimated 6.1 million people. Almost 20% of the world population reportedly has been suffering from AD. Furthermore, pediatric AD has a negative influence on children's growth. It may cause other emotional disorders such as character formation disorders such as a sense of alienation and lack of self-regard. Thus, it is recognized as a transnational problem.

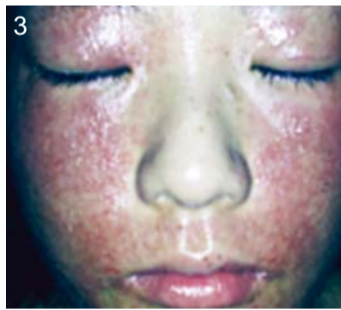
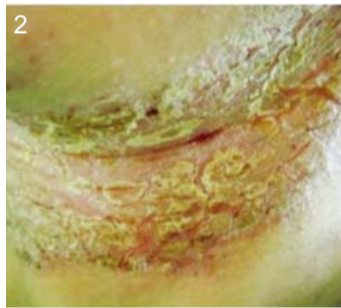

Now they are leading happy lives.

Sister Subin Kim (aged 26, Photo 3) had suffered from atopic dermatitis since the age of four. When she was a high school student, she wore a mask to hide her swollen and festered face, even in midsummer. After entering school as a college student, it got worse. She started to look back upon herself. She cut herself off from the worldly things that God hates and repented thoroughly. Then, she received Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer and was healed of it completely.

Now Sister Kim is working faithfully as a member of Immanuel Choir. She said, “I couldn't sleep well on many nights because of the sores oozing and pus on my face, but now I can sleep very well. I am very happy.” Now she is devoted to studying vocal music to give glory to God.

Sister Sehee Park (aged 22, Photo 5) had the worst state of atopic dermatitis, and even doctors shook their heads. But she was also healed by

Dr. Lee's prayer. After receiving prayer, scabs covered her whole body in three days. And they fell off soon and new flesh came out. She was completely healed of not only AD but also pimples.

Soojung Lee (aged 12, Photo 6) looked hideous because of atopic dermatitis and impetigo contagiosa. Her parents Deacon Daesung Lee and Deaconess Yumi Kim were reminded that a little child's disease is chiefly attributed to parents' wrongdoings. They repented of their lukewarm Christian lives and received Dr. Lee's prayer.

The following morning, the sore's oozing stopped and turned dry. The festering parts were covered with dark scabs. That evening, the scabs fell off and she was completely healed just three to four days after the prayer. Since then, she has been growing up healthily and happily and now is a member of Children's Sunday School's worship dance team.

Sister Jiyoung Lee (aged 21) used to sleep with her hands tied with bandages because of severe itchiness. Sister Nuri Ryu (aged 14) didn't wear shorts or short-sleeve shirts in midsummer because her friends teased her due to her skin. But both were also healed by Dr. Lee's prayer.

Daniel, who is the son of Dr. Daniel Fuentes Acosta, Director of World Christian Doctors Network, Mexico had had atopic dermatitis on his arms and legs since birth. The Manmin mission team was visiting Mexico. Dr. Fuentes heard from them that if one applies Muan Sweet Water or drinks it with faith, they can experience divine healing works. He applied the water to his son with faith. Amazingly, God perfectly healed him of it during the week.

Eric, in Kenya (aged 8, Photo 4) had atopic dermatitis from the third week of his birth. His face looked like he had been scalded and it smelled bad, so his family was driven out from their town. But when Bishop Dr. Myongho Cheong (Nairobi Manmin Holiness Church) prayed for him with the handkerchief on which Dr. Jaerock Lee had prayed, he was completely healed of it in just three weeks and his skin is now like a new born baby's.

The medical treatment of atopic dermatitis is accompanied by much patience, cost, toil, and likelihood of recurrence. But believers who were healed of AD all said that they were healed very quickly after they destroyed the wall of sins against God and received the prayer with faith and there are no scars, complications, or recurrence of the disease.

“And [Jesus] said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.” This is the great and foremost commandment. The second is like it, “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets” (Matthew 22:37-40).

Those who have a clear goal and dream in life have patience, perseverance and do their very best. When they achieve their goals, it guarantees the accomplishment of fame and material possessions. It is the same among believers. Those who are filled with the hope of Heaven unsparingly invest their time, possessions, and their very lives in doing the Lord’s work. With all their hearts they love God and devote themselves.

According to the words of the Lord Jesus we are to love God and our neighbors with all our hearts, but what kind of love is this and what does it really mean?

To love God with all your heart is to accomplish goodness.

If we love God with all our heart, we will unceasingly examine our words and deeds. We will continue to change ourselves, checking whether our words were good and our thoughts were proper in God’s sight. We can check how much goodness we have accomplished in our hearts by answering just a few questions.

Do you seek the benefit and advantage of others first, or do you seek your own first? When others prosper, do you rejoice as much as you would in your own works, or do you speak begrudgingly of others saying, “That person lacks in this and that aspect, so why is she so prosperous?” Do you lose

heart? When someone causes you a hard time, is your peace of heart broken?

Such people cannot be said that they long for the goodness of God even if they have listened to many messages and long for the grace. We have to meditate on the word heard and make every effort to become a person of goodness. This is how we have a true longing for spirit and love God with all our hearts.

There is one more thing for us to remember. God’s criterion of judgment is different from human criterion. Exodus 15:26 tells us that we should do righteousness not in our eyes but in God’s eyes. The goodness that people recognize is different from God-recognized goodness.

Some people look meek and polite to everyone, but may disregard others in heart. When somebody else’s educational viewpoint conflicts with their own, they may consider him or her as being uneducated and impolite and close their hearts toward the person. Some others have introspective characters and don’t like having disputes with others, so they don’t insist on their own opinions and tend to follow others’ advice. But it happens only because of their personality. They don’t serve others from their heart. They may think, “It seems that I always lose out in making peace with others,” and their ill feelings such as frustrations and discomfort become worse. They may also have difficulty discovering their evils because they think they served and gave room for benefits of others.

Some people say they are enduring trials, but they cannot do it with joy and thanksgiving. If they pass through persecutions for faith and financial trials with faith, hope and love, then their faces are covered with greater grace. But because they suppress and constrain themselves in their trials, sorrow increases to the extent hard times have passed. Then their faces show gloom and shades of anxiety. They think they have endured well for years, but the door to blessings has not opened as quickly as expected.

Still others appear to be sincere, diligent and sociable. They seem to take on the work of others as though it were their own. They are praised among others, but they have only a little longing for spirit. Like Martha, they have greater interest in their duties than in loving God and becoming sanctified.

They think they have goodness and are serving others. They may be deemed to be good by the standards of others and they themselves think they are good, but God does not acknowledge their goodness. If we want to love God with all our hearts just as Jesus said, we have to seek goodness in every aspect and realize what the goodness of God is and accomplish His goodness.

Secondly, to offer everything to God with all your heart is to accomplish spiritual love.

1 John 4:21 says, “And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also.”

Some believers seem to give God what they have with fervor, but do not do anything for other believers. They pray fervently, attend worship services arduously, and dedicate their time and money to God. But they staggeringly lack in considering and looking after the people around them.

They have given God many things they have, but they cannot bear complete fruits of blessing. Of course, they have no intention of doing harm to others or of causing evils toward others. They are just narrow-sighted in considering others and their character of heart is not so great to that extent. So, they may hurt others’ hearts and give discomfort to others, though it is not intentional.

Suppose someone has a fervent longing for spirit and diligently prays with fasting. She volunteers for many works and gives substantial offerings to God. But while praying, she does not pray for the souls and the kingdom of God that much. She seems to have a longing for spirit, but she doesn’t have a desire to be with the people around her.

Let me give you another example. A mission group divided into smaller groups to clean a large space. One group finished cleaning their part a little earlier than others. The other groups were still cleaning. If she had a broader heart, she would be able to recognize why the other groups have not finished and see the help they need. Those who have only a little spiritual love cannot think as if they were in the other’s shoes.

Jesus said in Matthew 22:39, “Love your neighbor as yourself”. I ask you to take care of many others with delicate love and broadened hearts. I wish for you to harbor many more souls with

love, generosity, and the Father’s heart. This is how you can love God with all your heart.

To love the Father with all your heart, thirdly, is to fulfill your God-given duties.

Those who love the Father not only have a godly love in their hearts, but come to express that love outwardly. They come to dedicate themselves to the kingdom of God saying, “What shall I give to my Father? How can I repay this grace?” Even without a title in the church, they may evangelize and take care of other members diligently, and volunteer in church ministries.

But some of them may lose the state of this fervor with the passing of time. Then, they will turn away from the works that are not entrusted to them and want more personal freedom. They seem to perform their outward duties arduously but neglect other duties.

Our God-given duties, big or small, must be performed not in men’s sight, but only in God’s sight. Duties must not be performed only in deeds but with faith, hope and love and with aroma of the heart. Suppose at the annual election, one desired to be elected as president of his group but became a secretary. If he faithfully serves as secretary with all his heart, he can offer a more beautiful aroma to God. Then, he can rejoice and give thanks simply from the fact that he was entrusted with a title such as secretary or manager. He will pray for and take care of group members, supporting the group president arduously. Suppose someone used to be group president but this year she was not elected as president. She doesn’t attend group meetings anymore and no longer serves. It means her former service was not true service.

In every event and activity I ask you to serve not only in the body but also to do it with all your heart for God. Then, you will not perform such works only with the sense of duty. When you serve with faith and love this way, you can become full of grace and the Spirit. This heart of service can be accepted as the fragrance of joy by God.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

God doesn’t see the appearances of people. He accepts the fragrance of heart, the aroma of love and reverent fear of Him. Every day, your goodness and love must increase and you must consider your God-given duties as precious. I pray in the name of the Lord that by doing so you will only give glory to God.

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The works of the Holy Spirit manifested for those born again as God's Children

We can reach perfect salvation only when we are born again in the name of Jesus Christ who saved us from sins and become sanctified and justified in the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:11). To help people accept Jesus Christ and be born again as God's children, to move their hearts and help them repent, and to help them love God; they are the fundamental works of the Holy Spirit and His major duties. Let's delve into the ministry of the Holy Spirit in four aspects.

1. Gifts

The gifts of the Holy Spirit refer to special works manifested by the Holy Spirit in God's love. Various things that God gives to His beloved children in His grace all can be said 'gifts'. Thus, they entail salvation, healing, and answers that are commonly given to believers. But there are also other gifts of the Holy Spirit individually given to people.

The gifts of the Holy Spirit in 1 Corinthians Chapter 12 include the word of wisdom, the word of knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, the effecting of miracles, prophecy, the distinguishing of spirits, various kinds of tongues, and the interpretation of tongues. God who precisely knows each person's heart, vessel, and inner heart gives each person the gifts in His will.

The greatest gift is love as said in 1 Corinthians 13. God urges us to pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts (1 Corinthians 14:1). It's because to the extent that we receive more spiritual gifts we can be more powerful and more deeply communicate with God.

God wants us to use the gifts for the kingdom of God. Thus, God's children should not avoid gifts but desire the greater gifts as said in 1 Corinthians 12:31. If you are a pastor, you should teach your flock the truth in a right way, show the works of the Holy Spirit, and let them experience the evidence of the living God.

2. Realization

God the Creator's giving His only begotten Son for sinners, it is unimaginably great love. If one realizes how high, great, and deep His love is, he cannot but love God ardently.

It is not difficult to cast off sins that God hates and please Him with life and heart as long as the Holy Spirit helps us. We will be able to obey anything with faith though it is something hard to obey and we will try our best to reveal only the glory of God.

However, many believers live without the assurance of salvation. Or many others think they received salvation and go to church on Sunday, but they do not know what sin and righteousness are and how judgment will come upon them since they haven't yet received the Holy Spirit.

Jesus clearly said only when we are born again of water and the Holy Spirit (John 3:5) and do the will of God (Matthew 7:21) can we enter Heaven. God also sent the Helper the Holy Spirit so that we can understand what sin, righteousness, and judgment are (John 16:8) and we can avoid the judgment of Hell.

Thus, God's children who received the Holy Spirit should fight against sins to the point of shedding blood (Hebrews 12:4), abstain from every form of evil (1 Thessalonians 5:22), and take hold of Heaven by force by doing righteousness.

3. The Holy Spirit's voice, urging, and guidance

If we are inspired and influenced by the Holy Spirit, we will experience the work of the Spirit who searches all things, even the depths of God (1 Corinthians 2:10-11). We can demolish the camp of Satan, prophesy the future things, and receive deep revelation of the spiritual world.

But since the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of the truth (1 John 5:7), He works to the extent that we accomplish the truth in our hearts. If we acknowledge God in every circumstance, pray, and commit everything to God with faith, we can hear the voice of the Holy Spirit even doing trivial matters and receive His urging and guidance.

If we are shown the way clearly in the help of the Holy Spirit, we can receive blessings in businesses or workplaces easily and give glory to God. He also lets us remember what we have to say when we preach the gospel to others or counsel others.

The Helper the Holy Spirit teaches us nicely like a private tutor so that we can understand better and obey the Word of God. The Holy Spirit who dwells in our hearts tells us what we are to say and do specifically and reminds us of the truth.

The urging of the Holy Spirit means that the Holy Spirit moves our hearts to do something. If we are strongly urged to fast and pray for some period, it is the urging of the Spirit. If we obey and pray with our heart and devotion, we can be led by the Holy Spirit.

4. Strength to pray

Once we are filled with the Holy Spirit, we don't feel tired even when we pray after we worked too much. Drowsiness or idle thoughts can't approach us and we can pray with faith and joy. The Holy Spirit also reminds us of prayer titles that we miss.

The Holy Spirit knows our every need and fills it up. He also helps our weakness and intercedes for us in the will of God (Romans 8:26-27). When our hearts are united as one with the Holy Spirit, we can offer up God-pleasing prayer.

Depending on how much we pray in the Holy Spirit, the amount of our prayer actually offered up to God is different, so God's answer and blessing will also be different. We shouldn't pray as we think or in our frameworks. Rather we should pray in the Holy Spirit. Then, God causes all things to work together for good so that we can receive His answer in the easiest way.

To pray in the Holy Spirit, it is important to pray with dedication from the bottom of the heart. We should offer up truthful prayer earnestly every moment, but we first should ask for spiritual strength to overcome the world, to pray fervently, to defeat Satan, and to live in the Word of God.

Next, it is important to arm ourselves with the Word of God. When we make the Word of God our bread of life, we can receive clear and detailed urging of the Holy Spirit.

On July 24, 1998, I attended Friday All-night service of Manmin Central Church for the first time. At that time, my family went to another church, but my wife was guided to Manmin by an acquaintance and she had received great grace in the Friday All-night Service. I desired to go to the church, too. Just as she said, the church was filled with the Holy Spirit all the time. Since I liked to sing praises, I felt happy as though I were in Heaven while listening to the choir's anthem, watching special performances, and singing praises and praying in the second half.

During the first week of September in 1998, I registered in Manmin Central Church and my Christian life changed a lot. Through the messages on keeping the whole Sabbath and giving the whole tithes, I came to understand why my business went bankrupt twice during the IMF crisis. And I listened to Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee's sermon 'The Message of the Cross'. While listening to it, I came to know the love of God the Father, why Jesus is our only Savior, and the spiritual meanings of Jesus' crucifixion and passion. It led me to have true faith.

In 2012, my workplace was in financial difficulties due to recession. At that time, I learned that my company had a deficit as much as my annual income. So I told the owner to hire another person whose annual salary was less than me. By the time, an elder in my church prepared for opening an insurance company and asked me to work together with him. So I retired from my job.

In fact, I was a timid man, so it was not easy to introduce insurance products to strangers. I was in charge of sales by giving a briefing that is the most common way of

sales, but I couldn't get any results. My company considered me and let me do the sales targeting CEOs. For me it was more comfortable and was enjoyable to me. I had been in charge of many fields of business including accounting, personnel management, and human resources. I counseled people and introduced our insurance products. However, contracts weren't made smoothly. Since my performance was bad for more than two years after starting to work as an insurance salesman, I spent all my savings and money from mortgage loan. I fell into a very difficult situation financially.

But I kept in my heart the Word, which reads in 3 John 1:2, "Beloved, I pray that in all respects you may prosper and be in good health, just as your soul prospers". And I was focused on making my soul prosper. I walked the right path, tried to pursue peace with my working partner, and threw away selfish motives and greed. When my performance was bad, I looked for my untruthful things and repented. I tried hard to live by the

Word of God.

Moreover, I stopped making jokes that I had habitually made to accomplish a truthful heart. I prayed fervently to cast off sinful natures from my heart. I worshiped in spirit and truth during services and praised with my heart. Eventually, I achieved the beautiful heart of spirit on March 31 in 2014.

Until the last week of March, my performance was bad so I was thinking that I should move to another company that offers monthly base payment. But then contracts were made with firms that I had counseled in March so I made up my mind to try it again. In April, after I achieved the heart of spirit, God started to give me blessings in full scale. I had given 100 US dollars as a tithe but I came to give 1,000 US dollars. Hallelujah!

I used the same words in sales as those words that I had used previously, but the responses from the CEOs were very good. Moreover, they even introduced other CEOs to me. Seeing it, I became assured that I was under the guidance of God.

When I held God's Word of promise in my heart, prayed, and acted upon it, God fulfilled it.

I am a member of Shalom Choir, a leader of Peniel Chorus, and a sub-district leader of my parish. My wife is a cell leader. My first daughter is a seminary student called by God and a member of Heavenly Voice Chorus of Performing Arts Committee. My second daughter is a member of Crystal Singers. I give all thanks and glory to God who blessed my family to stay healthy and lead happy Christian lives.
