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“We Must Fulfill God’s Love and Justice in Our Hearts”

Manmin Leadership Conference 2015 Was Held with the Flow of Whole Spirit Running



Manmin Leadership Conference 2015 was held amidst the flow of whole spirit. Dr. Jaerock Lee (Photo 1) delivered the message; Heavenly Voice Chorus and Heavenly Dance Team offered up special performances (Photo 3); pastors, workers, and members in attendance praised together waving flags of nations (Photo 2); and Men’s Mission leaders (Photo 4).

From June 29 to July 1 in 2015, Leadership Conference 2015 was held under the theme of “Love” (1 John 4:16). God gave them the flow of whole spirit in 2015. In order for them to complete whole spirit they have to understand God’s love and justice and fulfill them in their hearts.

The conference was held in Vivaldi Park in Gangwon Province and people joined in the main auditorium’s Diamond Hall and other nine smaller auditoriums. There were many pastors, workers, and members from 23 countries including Canada, the U.S., Belgium, Israel, Estonia, DR Congo, and India.

In 2015, God gave Manmin members the flow of whole spirit—the faith to please God (1 Thessalonians 5:23). While they had been increasing faith with longing, this conference was held. It was simultaneously interpreted in six languages: English, Chinese, Japanese, Russian, Mongolian, and Indonesian.

Dr. Jaerock Lee started the message saying that we should understand love and justice that are God’s original nature in order to complete whole

spirit. He first talked about love; the love of God who prepared everything for human cultivation, sacrificed all, and gave us everything. He described God’s sorrow and lamentation when He left His only begotten Son Jesus on the cross to save us. Also, he explained about God’s love embedded in the Creation.

Secondly, he explained about justice. Justice is the rules or the standard God set. It works like a mathematical formula. When we substitute our case in the formula of justice, we can predict the consequence. Some cases are like intertwined wefts and warps, and we need to enter into deeper spiritual levels to unravel the rule of justice more exactly.

The third point was that love and justice should be harmonized. To explain God’s love and justice Dr. Lee cited the cases of Noah’s Flood, the Judgment of Sodom and Gomorrah, the Warning of Judgment on Nineveh, and the Gleaning Salvation during the Seven-year Great Tribulation. The Lord’s love and justice were explained through His ministry of salvation through the crucifixion, the

case of the woman who was caught in the very act of adultery (John 8), and the case of Judas Iscariot. They also looked back upon the shepherd’s love and justice spread through the flow of spirit and whole spirit from 2010.

Then, it was explained how Elijah, Enoch, Abraham, Moses, and Apostle Paul filled love and justice and achieved whole spirit. These examples showed that we should fulfill deeper levels of goodness and love and achieve faithfulness in all aspects to enter whole spirit.

Fourthly, Dr. Lee gave examples of some church pastors and leaders and explained why their spiritual growth had stagnated. The reasons were as follows: the framework of righteousness, which leans more toward justice; the framework of goodness, which leans more towards love; and the deficiencies of both love and justice. He added why some members stood still in spirit.

Lastly, he said, “God’s love is perfect because His love contains justice. His love and justice are incomparably at the highest level. They cannot be separated, but are

to be harmonized. God’s children can bear fruit of whole spirit by understanding His love and justice and achieving them.”

Additionally, during the afternoon of the first day, Mrs. Boknim Lee, President of Manmin Prayer Center, led the Fullness of the Holy Spirit Prayer Meeting. The attendees repented, became filled with the Holy Spirit, and made up their minds to grow up in faith quickly and achieve the heart of spirit and whole spirit through the conference. On the morning of the second day, Pastor Heejin Lee, Chairperson of Performing Arts Committee, delivered the message and prayed with the attendees. They came to have more hope for Heaven and feel more love of God. They praised and offered up their aroma of hearts. On the third day, they had fun in the water park.

At this end time, God is blessing us to listen to the Word of life, to pray, and to see signs, wonders, and powerful works so that we can achieve the heart of whole spirit and join His providence. Glory and thanks be to God!

“I love those who love me; and those who diligently seek me will find me” (Proverbs 8:17).



God is always preparing good things to give to His children both for their spirits and their bodies. God meets His children when they open their hearts and then seek Him with their whole heart. He also leads them to the way of answers and blessings.

What should we do to meet the living God? The most fundamental and important thing in meeting God is earnestly wanting to meet Him (Proverbs 8:17; Jeremiah 29:13).

1. You should seek God earnestly from your heart

God loves us above all else and He seeks us first. However, God will not coerce us to open our hearts so He can come in and meet us. He works according to His justice, so only when we willingly open our hearts can He come into our hearts and meet us.

It is just as written in Revelation 3:20, “Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.” And Matthew 5:3 reads, “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.”

To have a ‘poor’ spirit, first of all we have to free our heart of the things that hinder us from seeking God such as worldly pleasures and meaningless desires. Then, we will have an earnest desire to meet God. Also, when we humbly seek God, He can come upon our heart.

Most people become poor in spirit only when they face difficulties. If

you have a problem that cannot be solved by any worldly means, I hope you will rejoice and give thanks. This is the best opportunity for you to be able to earnestly seek God and meet Him.

Psalm 40:2 says, “He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, and He set my feet upon a rock making my footsteps firm.” Isaiah 55:6 reads, “Seek the LORD while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near.” If you have earnest heart, now you have to go to the places where you can meet God.

Now, let’s delve into how to meet the living God in detail. You can meet Him through the Word, prayer, praise, and worship services.

2. You should listen to, realize, and practice God’s Word

The Bible tells us who God is and what His will is for mankind. It tells us especially about how much God loves us. Through the Bible, we come to understand these things, and to that same extent our faith in God grows up. What’s important in meeting God, we must live according to the Word as well as read and hear about the Bible.

The Bible has been written by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, so we should understand the true meaning with the Holy Spirit’s help. Then, the Word will be living and active. It will pierce into the division of our soul, spirit, and even joints and marrow (Hebrews 4:12). Knowing God’s Word literally or just as knowledge does not guarantee meeting God. When we obey the Word telling us to do, not do, keep, or cast away certain things, various life problems will be resolved, and blessings will come upon us.

3. You should cry out in prayer with earnest

If we earnestly pray, we will be inspired by the Holy Spirit, and we will understand God’s heart and will contained in the Word. Also, we will be given the power to follow God’s Word. Above all, prayer is not a monologue, but is the direct communication channel through which we can meet God and it is a conversation with God.

How to Meet God

When His children pray, God hears them and touches their hearts, that is He gives them realization and understanding. This way, we can communicate with God. Namely, we can have a personal fellowship with God. Moreover, if we pray according to God’s will, He will answer us in accordance with the law of justice. Through these occasions, we can certainly meet and experience God.

Again, earnestness is something very important when we try to meet God through prayers. We know what the blind man Bartimaeus did to meet Jesus. He cried out as recorded in Mark 10:47 saying, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” When other people rebuked him to be quiet, he raised his voice even more. It was because his desperation was so great.

Many prophets also cried out in their prayers (1 Samuel 7:9), and Jesus also prayed with all His strength and His sweat became like drops of blood falling to the ground (Luke 22:44). If you cry out with such an earnest heart when you pray, you cannot have any idle thoughts or drowsiness. Thus, I hope you will pray with all your heart and cry out with determination of the overflowing certainty of meeting God. In doing so, I hope you will be able to meet God personally in your lives.

4. You should offer up beautiful praises

God is very pleased with praises. Similarly, when His children lift Him up with praises, God’s heart, eyes, and ears are set towards His children.

This is the reason why we are filled with joy and emotions when we sing praises.

In the Bible, we can see that the fathers of faith also offered God praises from time to time. One of the most significant of these figures is David.

David enjoyed singing praises whether it was when he was alone tending the flock or when he was offering sacrifices to God as the king. God loved David and He was with him all the time in the praises. The praise sung by David also contained the power of light. When David played the harp, the evil spirits that were afflicting Saul went away. In 2

Kings 3, Elisha was moved by God and received God’s Word when the minstrel played.

We naturally have to praise God who saved us and is leading us to Heaven, but when we praise God’s goodness, love, and power, He again shows His love back to us. I hope you will meet God every day through beautiful praises.

5. You should worship in spirit and truth.

The forefathers of faith in the Old Testament times communicated with God through sacrifices. King Solomon met and experienced the God of wisdom and from whom all blessings flow, by giving one thousand sacrifices. Those sacrifices are equivalent to the worship services in the New Testament era.

In John 4:24, Jesus says, “God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.” It means we can meet God who is spirit if we worship in spirit and in truth. Simply stated, worshipping in spirit and in truth refers to worship offered with all our hearts in the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Whether in official church worship services or in small group services, we can meet God just by worshipping well, and it’s a great blessing. Furthermore, worship services contain all the other passageways to meet God, namely, the Word, prayer, and praise. Grace will come upon us from above when we worship in spirit and truth with all our hearts. We will be overflowing with hope for Heaven, peace, and joy.

It is the evidence showing that we have met the living God. If we keep the grace in our lives, we can always meet God who is with us.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, to meet God we should go to the places where we can meet God with earnest through the Bible, prayer, praise, and worship services. We should remember that the most important things are the most basic things. I pray in the name of the Lord that you will quickly come forth as true children and walk with God on this earth, and then dwell with God forever in New Jerusalem.

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What Kind of Prayer Brings Down Answers?

Prayer is the conversation of love between God and God's saved children. Psalm 37:4 reads, "Delight yourself in the LORD; and He will give you the desires of your heart." If the aroma of our prayer pleases God and moves His heart, we can receive answers to not only what we ask but also our heart's desires that we did not ask.



Prayer in goodness

To please God, who is goodness itself, our prayer has to be a profession of goodness coming from a good heart.

People with goodness in heart speak only beautiful words of goodness. Their voices and posture during prayer give out fragrance of goodness. But if one has evil in his hearts, he will pray with evil to that same extent.

Suppose there is a person who prays saying, "God, let my husband repent and receive salvation, even if it means he has to break his leg." She is praying for the salvation of a soul. But in the light of the truth, this prayer is evil and foolish.

Say you pray, "God, bless my shop, and send me all the next-door shop's customers and I will

give You a lot more money for church construction offering and increase charitable offerings." If you pray like this, it is very difficult for the blessing to come because it cannot be stored as a pleasant aroma before God. Also, prayers in despair, complaining, and in sorrow are not prayers of goodness.

Some may pray to God, "Other people easily receive blessings and testify, but I always live in hardships." Such prayer is never of goodness and it is a faulty profession.

But the fact is that they are praying impatiently. They are praying with envy and jealousy and with their selfish desire to be recognized and blessed quickly. They are praying out of sorrow and resentment without having any faith, due to the evil in their heart.

If you see 'other people' receive God's blessing, you can learn from them. And you should know

that they do not 'easily receive blessings' but they try hard to act in Light and thereby receive the blessings. And, if you 'always live in hardships', it shows that you have not obeyed God's Word. So, you should look back on your Christian life.

Some of you may think you don't have a good heart-field. Then, you just should patiently try your best to change your heart-field into good soil. If you think you are being renewed too slowly, it is not because your heart-field is bad but because you do not practice God's Word.

If we do not have evil in our hearts, we can profess with thanks and joy in any circumstance and we will not say anything that displeases God. We will offer up prayers of thanks all the time and prayers of faith for answers to our heart's desires. When we pray in goodness according to God's will, God will receive the aroma of prayer and answer it.

Prayer relying on the Lord

If you rely on your thoughts and your strength you will run out of things to pray about and you will become physically tired after a period of time. But if you pray by the help of the Holy Spirit and in the Lord-given grace and strength, you can pray as much as you want.

If you have had faith for some time, when the prayer point is given, you know what to pray and how to pray for it. If you habitually pray repetitively reciting things you know in prayer, it might be as if you were playing a recording of your

voice. Such prayer will not become the aroma of prayer and this kind of prayer cannot be accepted by God.

God's children should make a habit of relying on the Holy Spirit while praying. They should pray in the Holy Spirit's help. Prayer must be offered from an earnest heart, with the contents that God needs to hear by the works of the Holy Spirit from moment to moment.

For example, when you cook rice in an electric rice cooker, you can just put a certain amount of rice and water and press the button. But if you are cooking rice in a pot, you have to expend more effort and heart. You have to measure the rice amount and the water level. During cooking you

must also manage the heat. In the same manner, saying the same thing habitually and praying in the Holy Spirit are so different.

You will be inspired by the Holy Spirit if you listen to His voice and try to seek the will of God. God will manage the contents and flow of your prayer, so the contents of the prayer will spring up from you. For example, when you pray for the church construction, the Holy Spirit will let you know what kind of focus you should have each time you pray. Then, you can also receive the inspiration on the details about what to pray for in that focused area. When we rely on the Lord and pray for things that are necessary at the time in the Spirit's inspiration, then God is pleased with the prayer.

Prayer in love

If you love God, the church, the shepherd, and souls, you shed tears thinking of God's love in prayer. You also become fervent when you think of the Lord who tearfully prays for us in Heaven without consuming anything.

Also, when you pray fervently for the church

and the shepherd with love, you should have a burning fire in you. When you think of the souls who commit sins and are dying without knowing the gospel, your heart should be torn apart.

It stands that if you have such a heart, you must also have spiritual love. I urge you to check as to whether you are faithful in all God's house, whether you seek others' benefit first, and whether you sacrifice yourself to serve others. When others see you, they should be saying,

"She is really like 'the one who prays'. She has generosity and love. She is humble and meek and lovable."

Only then can you be recognized that your profession of love for God, the church, and the shepherd is true. Only the tearful prayers and earnest crying out with love can be offered up to God as thick aroma. We should pray with love for souls who commit sins and are on the way to death as if they are our children.

In November 2012, I received *Manmin News* in Tamil and an invitation card to Chennai Manmin Church's 8th Anniversary Event from a woman on the street. I had attended the church when I was 11 years old following my aunt, so it was nice to hear about the church again. I attended the event and there received a lot of grace from the sermon and performance.

Afterwards, I went to the church and joined Manmin Central Church's worship services via GCN (www.gcntv.org). I learned how to pray and worship from Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee and witnessed God's powerful works that are being unfolded today. I was amazed.

While reading his testimonial memoirs *Tasting Eternal Life before Death* in Tamil I was greatly moved by Senior Pastor's love and sincerity toward God and his fervent love for souls. I also read *The Message of the Cross*, and through the book I realized God's providence in human cultivation and Jesus Christ's love on the cross. After that, my Christian life was renewed.

While I was leading a happy Christian life, my grandfather experienced a great and powerful work of God.

In September 2014, my 78-year-old grandfather, who had become weakened, suddenly collapsed due to a stroke and he fell into a coma. He stayed in a hospital, but the doctor said there was no chance for

his survival. So, we brought him home on October 6.

We were in sorrow because there wasn't anything we could do for him. We just had to wait and see his death. At the right time, our church was joining Manmin Central Church's Special Daniel Prayer Meeting.

I offered up a vowed prayer for my grandfather, and heard that Pastor Joseph Han would go to Korea for the central church's anniversary. I gave him my grandfather's picture and offerings and asked him to receive Senior Pastor's prayer on my behalf.

On October 10, Senior Pastor prayed for him on the picture and my grandfather came to life through the prayer! He recognized his family, ate well, stood up and sat down and walked freely on his own. Hallelujah!

This served as a good opportunity for my eight relatives who were attending Chennai Manmin Church to increase their faith. My nephew Santoshi, age 5, was scalded by hot water, but he was healed through handkerchief prayer and Muan Sweet Water.

I am a junior in college. I go to school after I receive Senior Pastor's prayer for the day and I drink Muan Sweet Water every morning. I read

the Bible, memorize important verses every day, and I belong to the Male Singers' Team in Chennai Manmin Church.

I want to be a successful businessman after graduation so that I

can support the church financially and help the poor. I am deeply thankful to the Lord of love who has led me to live a good and beautiful life.

In March 2015, I had an accident. I stood on a chair to fix a fluorescent light at home. Then, the chair's leg broke and I fell. I lost consciousness. I was alone. A little while later I came round, but I was still only half conscious. I received Dr. Jaerock Lee's

prayer for the sick recorded on the Automatic Response System. Soon, I became fully conscious.

A week later, I realized that after the accident I had had a headache and dizziness and no strength in my lower body. I attended Daniel Prayer Meeting every night and prayed for an hour more in the early morning. During the prayer, I looked for the reason why I had not been under God's protection. I realized that I had done many things in my will, not in God's will

although I thought I was faithful.

But I still had a headache and felt dizzy. I could not walk properly and lost my appetite and lost weight. In late March, I received Grand Parish Pastor's handkerchief prayer (Acts 19:11-12) and I came to have fewer headaches and was able to walk properly.

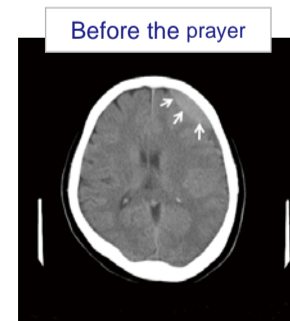
To know exactly what was wrong, I went to the hospital and had an MRI scan on April 16. The result was not good so I also had a CT scan. A half of brain was clear but the other was cloudy. Small veins burst, blood collected, and my brain was compressed. I was in a need of surgery. I was shocked, but I wanted to be healed by God since I had seen countless powerful works.

I prayed earnestly and repented. I had insisted on my own opinions because I thought I was right and gave hard times to others. I also had broken peace and sometimes judged and condemned others when they were not in agreement with me. I repented of it.

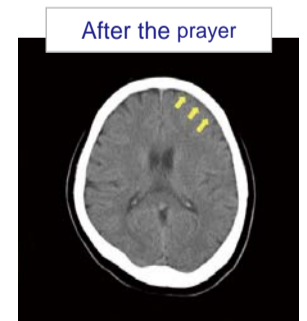
On April 27, by the help of Rev. Heesun Lee, Guidance Pastor of Women's Mission, I received Senior Pastor's prayer transcending space

and time. After the prayer, all my symptoms were gone. However, I still felt something unresolved. I tried to figure out what I needed to repent of. Soon, it came to my mind that I had felt discomfort towards a pastor. I repented of it. Then, my condition became completely normal. Everything was renewed by Senior Pastor's power of re-creation. Hallelujah!

I was born again. I am trying to break my self-righteousness and consider others with humbleness and kindness. I feel very happy. I give all thanks and glory to God who blessed me in spirit and body.
