

On Monday, November 10 last year, I suddenly began to feel pain in my right knee. From Wednesday evening, the pain became so severe that it hurt whether I knelt or straightened my leg, and even walking was difficult. I even wondered if I could continue attending Daniel Prayer Meeting held every night.

Still, I attended the prayer meeting at our local sanctuary, and the next day I visited a hospital to find out the cause. The doctor diagnosed me with arthritis and said the pain would likely

worsen, eventually making it difficult even to walk, and recommended treatment. However, I chose not to receive it and returned home.

On Monday the 17th, when pastor Lee Miyoung led Daniel Prayer Meeting, she invited the members of our parish to the main church. In fact, the main church is about an hour and a half away from my home, requiring transfers between buses and the subway

and climbing many stairs, so I briefly wondered whether my legs could

endure it. Still, with a longing heart, I attended.

Thankfully, during the prayer meeting, I received great grace and had time to repent as I reflected on myself. After finishing the prayer meeting filled with grace, I made the hour-and-a-half journey back home, and something amazing happened.

Without any injections or medication, my knee pain began to subside starting the next day, Tuesday, and my movements became noticeably smoother. On Wednesday, it was as though I had never been in pain at all. Since then, I have had no pain and have been living my daily life comfortably. Hallelujah! I give all thanks and glory to our good Father God who healed me completely.



I was healed of sepsis that had threatened my life

In early November last year, I was suddenly struck by severe pain throughout my body. Frequent high fevers caused excessive sweating, followed by shaking and chills. The nausea persisted, and my strength rapidly declined to the point where even taking a few steps was difficult. It felt as though the tendons and muscles throughout my body were giving way, making it hard to support myself. As time passed, my joints weakened, and I struggled day by day with constant pain.

I serve as a pastor at Nairobi Manmin Church, overseeing several areas within a parish, and I also teach and guide children in Sunday school. Although I normally carried out these duties with joy, the pain that followed even the smallest movement eventually made it difficult for me to perform my duties and attend the church events.

After about two weeks, my condition worsened. I could barely eat, and whatever I ate, I ended up vomiting soon after. My body became noticeably weaker, and at times I would burn with fever and break out in cold sweats, only to be overtaken by intense chills and trembling. Eventually, I became bedridden for several days, unable to get up.

As my condition continued to worsen, I went to the hospital in



the fourth week of November for a thorough examination. The doctor said that it was a blood infection caused by bacteria entering my bloodstream and that it was a very serious condition that could lead to, or had already progressed to, sepsis. Sepsis is a life-threatening illness in which bacteria or microorganisms spread through the blood and trigger severe inflammation throughout the body.

In this desperate situation, I resolved to rely wholly on God for healing. That week, I decided to attend the divine healing meeting held on November 28 and receive prayer. At Manmin Church in Nairobi, our GCN team records the main church's divine healing meeting and shares it during the all-night service. I also participated in that overnight service.

As I listened to the message preached

by Senior Pastor Soojin Lee, "According to Your Confession, So It Shall Be" (Romans 10:10), I deeply repented of the negative words I had spoken carelessly and of the complaints I had voiced whenever things did not go my way. I also reflected on the times when I had failed to trust God fully.

After the message, when Senior Pastor finished praying for the sick, an astonishing change took place. Suddenly, sweat poured from my entire body, and I felt intense heat, as if the fire of the Holy Spirit had come upon me. When the sweating stopped, the heat faded, and it felt as though a cool, refreshing breeze gently wrapped around my whole body.

At that moment, all the pain and suffering that had weighed me down vanished as if they had never existed. My body became completely different, and new strength surged into my once extremely weakened body. I no longer staggered or felt unstable, but was able to walk normally with a steady stride. This was truly the marvelous work of the living God. Hallelujah!

Even now, two months later, I continue to live in good health and faithfully carry out my duties in the church. I give all thanks and glory to our good God who healed me in the midst of a blood infection and the danger of sepsis that could've claimed my life.

My blurred vision in both eyes improved to 20/13

My eyesight gradually began to decline in 2019, and during a health checkup in December 2021, my vision measured 20/25 in the left eye and 20/20 in the right. Severe presbyopia developed as well, making it difficult to read even the Bible or other materials. I eventually used reading glasses, but reading the Bible was still not easy.

Around that time, I began using

the Muan Sweet Water Spray which contained water that turned from bitter to sweet (Exodus 15:25). I applied it to my eyes consistently every morning as soon as I woke up. After using the sweet water, I could clearly feel my eyesight improving through 2022 and 2023.

At a health checkup in December 2023, my vision measured 20/13 in the left eye and 20/20 in the right,



showing noticeable improvement. Even more remarkably, at my December 2025 checkup, both eyes measured 20/13, indicating a full recovery of good vision in both eyes. Hallelujah!

Now, I have no symptoms of presbyopia and can read the Bible and various materials comfortably. I give all thanks and glory to our good Father God who healed my eyes.



In early November last year, I fell in the bathroom and injured my left back and lower waist. The pain was so severe that even sitting or standing was difficult, and whenever I turned my body or tried to get up, stabbing pain surged through my body, making everyday life challenging. I had to wear a back brace to ease the pain.

After X-rays at the hospital, I was told that a spinal fracture was suspected. However, instead of receiving hospital treatment, I registered as a patient for the divine healing meeting. While attending the

Even while sleeping, intense pain would strike, but each time I felt assured that Father God was healing me, and peace quickly followed. I found myself giving thanks for how He had protected me and strengthened me until now. Day by day, I prepared for the divine healing, receiving pastor Soojin Lee's prayer.

The pain that had felt like being cut with a knife gradually weakened, giving way to a tingling sensation, and

eventually disappeared completely. On November 25, I even took part in the recording of the Power Praise Christmas Special, dancing and praising freely as if I had never been in pain. Hallelujah!

To this day, I have no pain at all and can live my daily life without restriction. Moreover, my posture—especially my lower back and spine, which had long been hunched—became noticeably straighter, and even my high blood pressure returned to normal. I am now healthier than before. I give all thanks and glory to God who healed me completely.





The Last Seven Words on the Cross 6

"It Is Finished"

According to John 19:30, Jesus tasted the sour wine and said, "It is finished," before bowing His head and giving up His spirit. Jesus accepted the sponge soaked with sour wine not merely to quench His physical thirst. A profound spiritual meaning is also found here.

Jesus receiving the sour wine signifies that He had completed the Law of the Old Testament through love and had taken upon Himself the curses and sins of all mankind. In the Old Testament era, before Jesus came to this earth, people had to sacrifice animals and offer their blood to God whenever they sinned.

However, because Jesus Himself was nailed to the cross and shed His blood, offering a once-for-all, eternal sacrifice (Hebrews 10:11–12), anyone who receives Jesus Christ through faith can now be forgiven for their sins. The grace of redemption through Jesus Christ is the "new wine," and Jesus Himself drank the "sour wine" to give that grace to us.

Then, why did Jesus say, "It is finished," after the sponge soaked with sour wine touched His lips?

The reason Jesus came to this earth was to open the way of

salvation for all humanity by dying on the cross. He could confess "It is finished" because He had perfectly fulfilled this divine providence for human salvation.

Jesus is the Word who became flesh. Coming to this earth, He not only preached the gospel of heaven and healed every disease and sickness, but He also followed God's will and bore the cross, opening the way of salvation for all mankind who were headed toward death.

By sacrificing Himself unto death, He fulfilled the Law through love and gained a

complete victory by breaking the stronghold of the enemy devil. Without love, how could He have endured the immense pain of the cross? As Jesus completely fulfilled the Law through His death on the cross, He declared, "It is finished."

Since the Bible is a message given to all children of God, we must recognize that Jesus' word, "It is finished," is also a message for us. Then, what does this word mean spiritually? Just as Jesus completely fulfilled the providence of salvation by obeying God's will and providence even unto death, we, as children of God, must also become people who fulfill everything by living according to God's will.

By fighting against sin even to the point of shedding blood and casting it off, we must cultivate spiritual love (1 Corinthians 13:4–7), the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22–23), and the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:3–10), thereby growing to resemble the heart of the Lord. We must also faithfully carry out our calling, praying earnestly, evangelizing, and serving faithfully so that we can lead many souls into the Lord's embrace.
